

A few more IMPORTANT TIPS

for success with your Parelli Natural Performer Saddle:

WHEN POSITIONING your saddle on your horse, be certain to line it up with your horse's SCAPULA to insure comfort and fluid motion for his/her shoulders:

↓ This point is to be BEHIND the SCAPULA at REST

X

This point is to be BEHIND the SCAPULA at MAXIMUM Range

Also note:

The Theraflex pad should be CENTERED under the saddle. (front to back and left to right)

IMPORTANT to know ABOUT ADJUSTING your STIRRUPS:

Your FENDERS are probably shipped in the very shortest position possible, for purposes of protecting the leather from damage during transit.

TO LENGTHEN your Stirrup position:

SLIDE BLEVINS Buckle UP to unlock. PULL DOWN on the fender with both hands, or pull down with one hand while pushing UP the adjustment strap. Insert pegs in appropriate holes and slide Blevins back down to lock in place.

TO SHORTEN your Stirrup position:

Slide Blevins Buckle up. PUSH UP the fender while pulling down on the stirrup adjustment strap. Insert pegs in appropriate holes and slide Blevins buckle back down.

CAUTION: It should not be necessary to unbuckle your Stirrup Hobble Strap during the above processes. Leave it buckled in place around the twisted ends of your fender, just above the Stirrup, below the locking pegs.

Also IMPORTANT: Be certain that your Stirrup Hobble Strap (which is designed to keep your stirrups from falling off when the Blevins Buckle slides up and apart from the locking pegs) is NOT wrapped around your Stirrup Leather Adjustment strap (See photos below)
